## Friday, Oct. 16

### **Check-In and Unloading:**

**Volunteers:** If you have turned in your Registration form and your Release form, please find the Volunteer Coordinator. Once you have your name checked off and receive your volunteer stamp, you may proceed to your designated area. If you have not pre-registered, extra forms will be available. Please pull into the parking area and complete your paperwork before returning to the entrance area. Due to insurance liability issues, we cannot allow anyone on the site unless their paperwork is complete.

**Reenactors:** You can unload on-site anytime **AFTER 12:00 noon**. If you have turned in your Registration form and your Release form, you may drive through the entrance (look for the check-in sign) and stop when you see the Site Coordinator. Once you have your name checked off, receive your meal ticket and volunteer ribbon, you may proceed to your designated area and begin unloading. If you have not pre-registered, extra forms will be available. Please pull into the parking area and complete your paperwork before returning to the entrance area. Due to insurance liability issues, we cannot allow anyone on the site unless their paperwork is complete. Please move your vehicle to the parking area as soon as possible after unloading.

**Camping:** You are welcome to camp on the event site. We are striving to have the reenactors area look as authentic as possible and would appreciate your help in keeping your camp as period correct as possible.

## Saturday, Oct. 17

### **Check-In and Unloading:**

**Volunteers:** If you have turned in your Registration form and your Release form, please find the Volunteer Coordinator. Once you have your name checked off and receive your volunteer stamp, you may proceed to your designated area. If you have not pre-registered, extra forms will be available. Please pull into the parking area and complete your paperwork before returning to the entrance area. Due to insurance liability issues, we cannot allow anyone on the site unless their paperwork is complete.

**Reenactors:** You can unload on-site between the hours of 7:00 and 9:00 a.m. All vehicles must be off the site by 9:00 a.m. Please read Friday Check-In and Unloading regarding your paperwork.

Those of you who have attended before will notice that we have moved the vendors from the reenactor area in order to give all of our visitors the feeling of going back in time. Please try and keep your area as period correct as possible.

**Lunch:** Lunch will be provided to all reenactors. You must have a meal ticket in order to receive lunch. You may pick up your lunch between 11:30 and 1:00 at a place to be announced.

**Packing Up:** No vehicles may enter the event site until 6:00 p.m. OR until all foot traffic is clear.

## Sunday, Oct. 18

Reenactors are welcome to camp overnight, but we ask that everyone please clear the event site by 12:00 noon on Sunday.
